

# Use a Template

Templates allows you to create projects with common pages (. dg5 files), [widget libraries](#), and [favorites](#). Because a template contains . dg5 files, templates also let you share [components](#), [properties](#), [assets](#), and [dataflow](#) across projects.

To download a template from the DGLogik website:

1. Download the . zip file from [www.dglogik.com/downloads](http://www.dglogik.com/downloads).
2. [Import the project](#) that you want to use as a template. The project must be saved as a [template](#).

To use a template:

- [Create a new project](#), with the template selected.
